






OCEAN CONTAINER SPECS

There are many different sizes and types of shipping container. When shipping cargo it is helpful to know what type of shipping container will best suit your needs. Often the dimensions and maximum weight will impact on what type of equipment can be used.

The following guide shows the different types of shipping containers that can be used as a starting point for determining your shipping requirements.

* The seller can deliver the goods to the buyer (1) when the named place is the seller's premises the goods are delivered when they are loaded on the means of transport provided by the buyer; or (2) when after having been loaded on the buyer's transport, then reach the named other place, and are at the disposal of the carrier or another person as nominated by the buyer

** Buyer should pay unloading costs, unless such costs are for the seller's account per the contract of carriage

The chosen Incoterms Rules work as intended only if the parties specify the named place or port as precisely as possible. For example: FCA 38 Cours Albert, Paris France Incoterms 2020. The named place could be the shipper's premises - an airport or seaport - the consignee's specific location - or anywhere in between.
