



Mainfreight Air & Ocean Announcement

The Australian Government has announced changes to Import Processing Charge

The Senate had officially passed the Import Processing Charges Amendment Bill 2013 on the 12th December 2013

The federal budget, delivered on 14th May 2013 included a significant increase in the Import Processing Charge (IPC). This is to recover increased costs of import related cargo and trade functions undertaken by the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (ACBP)

Whether you are importing by sea or air you will be subject to these Import Processing Charges (IPC). These new price increases take effect on 1st January 2014.


Consignments valued under \$10,000 will remain at the current level which is \$50 for sea and \$40.20 for air.

Sea import declarations will be increased by \$102.60 to \$152.60 per consignment.

Air import declarations will be increased by \$81.90 to \$122.10

- Changes will come into effect on 1 January 2014
- Sea import increased to \$152.60 per consignment
- Air import increased to \$122.10
- Consignments valued under \$10,000 will stay at the current level
